

# **Landscape Committee Report**

**This year we planted additional cold and heat tolerant plants in the berm beds, but the water restrictions always make it difficult for them to survive. It is recommended that Knockout Roses be planted in the Spring, as they seem to do well in harsh environments. Cut ants are always a challenge and treatment is difficult with the surrounding wooded areas, where many of their trails lead to. The lighting on our Bahia Bay sign was completely refurbished and paint on the sign was touched up. The flag has been replaced and the worn out sprinkler system was repaired when it was found broken. The white fence at the end of the canal was repaired after someone drove into it. Property owners are asked to report any entrance way damage ie: water leaking, lights out, etc. to any of the BBPOA Board members. Suggestions to improve/enhance our entrance way are always welcome.**
